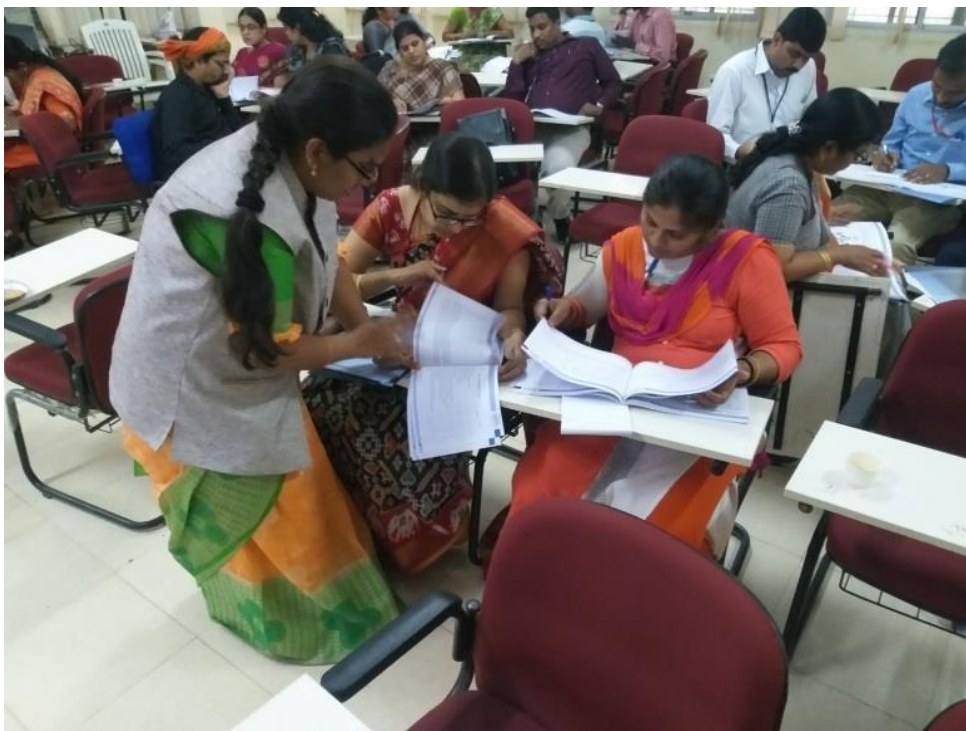


**Students were getting Insightful and Practical Knowledge from Industry Practitioners.**
