Instructions to the Students who are appearing for Supplementary and Backlog Examinations due to COVID - 19 Pandemic

1. The College has decided to conduct the Supplementary and Backlog Examinations in offline/conventional mode.
2. Students who are having Supplementary and Backlog subjects shall appear for these examinations.
3. Students who are writing examinations in the Forenoon session (10.00AM to 12.00 Noon) shall report to the college by 9.00 AM.
4. Students who are writing examinations in the Afternoon session (2.00PM to 4.00 PM) shall report to the college by 1.00 PM
5. The Question paper is descriptive and it contains two parts. Part-A (8x2=16marks) consists of Ten questions and student has to answer Eight questions out of Ten questions. Part-B consists of Six questions, student has to answer any three questions (3x18=54marks)(for R19,R18,R16 Regulations)
6. For R13 Regulation, Part-A (7x3=21marks) consists of Ten questions and student has to answer Seven questions out of Ten questions. Part-B consists of Six questions, student has to answer any three questions (3x18=54marks).
7. No Student is allowed to the Examination hall without the face mask. Further they must wear the face mask throughout the examination and advised to carry personal sanitizer.
8. Students must maintain the physical distancing throughout the examination. Students should not form into groups outside and within the college premises.
9. Candidates experiencing cough, cold, fever, etc., must inform to Chief Superintendent.
