Instructions to the Students who are appearing for the Online Mid Examinations/Class Test -1.

- B.E/B.Tech IV, VI, VIII Semester, MCA IV semester and MBA IV semester Mid Examination/Class Test-1 from April, 2021 will be held in ONLINE mode, as per the revised schedule.
- The Question paper is descriptive.
- The pattern of Question Paper is as follows.
B.E/B.Tech and MBA(R-19):- The question paper for Class test will be in two parts, Part-A and Part-B.
Part A is compulsory and carries six (6) marks.
Part-B carries fourteen (14) marks (students have to answer two questions with internal choice and each question carries seven (7) marks).
MCA(R-16):-The question paper for Class test will be in two parts, Part-A and Part-B.
Part A is compulsory and carries six (6) marks.
Part-B carries fourteen (14) marks (students have to answer any two questions from three questions given and each question carries seven (7) marks).
- Students can write on Answer Sheet and upload the self-attested scanned PDF file (maximum 5 MB). Students should make sure that scanned PDF document is legible.
- The duration of the Examination shall be 1hr+15 Minutes, i.e one hour for writing the exam and 15 minutes for uploading the pdf document of the answer script.
- students are advised to take the Exams from such a place where there is no power break down (where Inverter facility is available) and from such a fully charged computer with better internet connectivity.
- The students are required to keep all items such as A4 size Answer sheets, pen, pencil, eraser, sharpener, scale, calculator, data book (if any) etc. before the start of the exam.
- Use latest version of web Browsers like Google Chrome, Firefox, Edge, etc. for taking the Exam. A minimum Internet speed of 512 kbps is required.
