1. To include code numbers on the syllabus pages.

5. To include one more subject under all core electives and open electives.

The syllabus for all PG programs is approved.

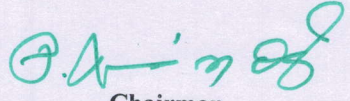
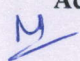
