COMPUTATION OF NORMALISED MARKS

Computer Science and Information Technology (CS) and Civil Engineering (CE) were conducted in two sessions in GATE 2024. For such multisession papers, a suitable normalisation is applied to take into account any variation in the difficulty levels of the question papers across sessions. The normalisation is done based on the assumption that, in multisession GATE papers, the distribution of the abilities of the candidates is nearly the same across sessions. M_q^g is the sum of mean and standard deviation of marks of the candidates in the paper considering all sessions

\bar{M}_{ti} is the average marks of the top 0.1% of the candidates in the i^{th} session and

M_{iq} is the sum of the mean and standard deviation of marks in the i^{th} session.

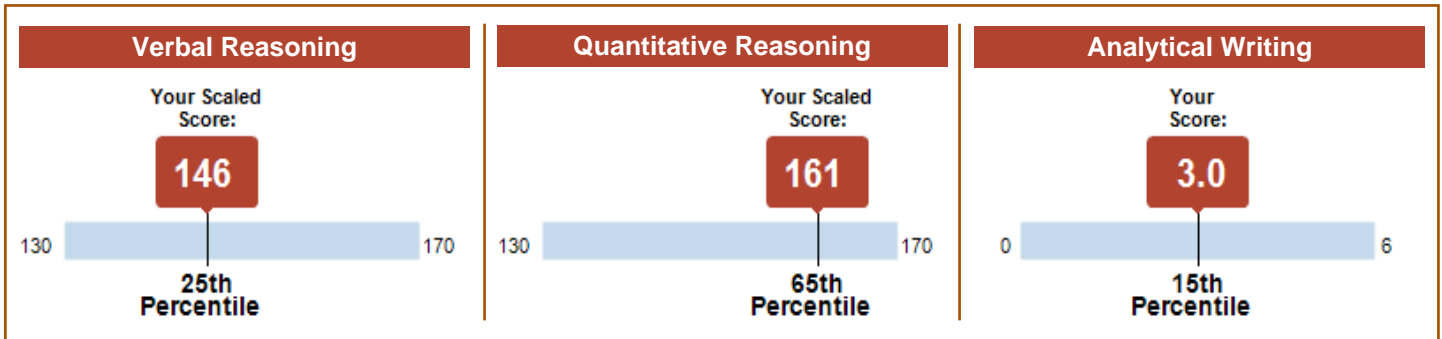
