Student Tuition

For tuition classification purposes you are considered a Non Resident.

Student Fees

Each year you will be responsible for paying out of pocket costs for a number of student fees, such as capital construction, recreation center, and bike program, student computing, athletic fee, mental health resource fee, career services fee, arts and cultural enrichment fee, student information system fee, Wardenburg additional campus care plan, and grad fee, which totals to approximately \$806.29 per semester (based on AY 23-24 rates) for students taking 7 or more credits. There is also a one-time new student fee of \$62.00 for all students and an additional fee for international students. These fees provide you access to a variety of amenities on campus, including an unlimited use of the Recreation Center, resources through the Career Services Office, and much more. The bill due date for incoming graduate students on appointment is the second due date of the semester, which is after you receive your first two paychecks. Health Insurance

The standard insurance, CU Student Gold Health Insurance Plan, available for graduate students typically costs \$2,311.00 per term (based in past year's rates). Please know as a student at the University you are REQUIRED to get health insurance.

Funding

Our departmental funding (TA/RA) is mainly reserved for our PhD students who are admitted with a funding commitment. For that reason, our master's admissions does not include any departmental funding, scholarships or fellowships.

Acceptance of Offer of Admission

Because of our policy of limited admission, we would appreciate a response from you, by confirming your intent to enroll on the [application status page](#) by April, 30th 2024. However, please be aware that Fall 2024 class enrollment begins on May 1st, 2024, and since CS classes are very popular, it will be to your advantage to confirm your intent to enroll before enrollments begin to ensure class enrollment.
