CIRCULAR

Sub: Instructions regarding Disciplinary Code to be observed during Sudhee and Shruthi - 2025 - Reg.

As you are aware, SUDHEE - The National-Level Technical Fest and SHRUTHI - the Annual Sports and Cultural Fest are the flagship events of our institute, serving as a platform to unite, celebrate our achievements, and showcase the exceptional talent and dedication of our students and staff.

To ensure the smooth execution of these events while upholding the institute's values and standards, all students are required to strictly adhere to the following disciplinary guidelines. Any instance of misconduct, indecent appearance, or violation of the code of conduct will be taken seriously and may result in stringent disciplinary action.

Disciplinary Code for Sudhee & Shruthi - 2025 :

- 1) All students must carry their institute ID cards at all times during the events.
- 2) Any altercation or argument with security personnel or staff on duty will be dealt strictly.
- 3) Entry passes will be issued to parents and alumni upon request.
- 4) In addition to parents, maximum of two siblings are allowed with valid ID proof (preferably AADHAR card) only in case of award winning students, they also should obtain the entry passes.
- 5) Requests for entry passes must be submitted to the AEC on or before 4th March, 2025.
- 6) Event participants must obtain entry passes through the faculty coordinator of the respective event.
- 7) Once issued, entry passes are non-transferable and valid only for the designated person.
- 8) Only individuals with valid ID cards or authorized entry passes will be permitted on campus.
- 9) Any damage to institute property will be considered a serious offense.
- 10) Sharing or misusing an ID card is a gross violation of institute rules.

- 11) Entry is allowed only through main gate.
- 12) Any misbehaviour, altercation with fellow students or staff, or involvement in prohibited activities such as the consumption or possession of alcohol, drugs, or smoking will be treated as a severe offense.
- 13) All students must strictly adhere to the dress code as previously communicated.
- 14) The main gate will be closed by 06:00 PM on 7th and 8th March, 2025.

Any violation of the above mentioned rules or any other act of misconduct will attract severe disciplinary action, including potential expulsion from the college.

All students are expected to uphold the institute's disciplinary code at all times. Let us work together to maintain the integrity and reputation of our institution by demonstrating exemplary behaviour during Sudhee & Shruthi - 2025.
